Dear U13 Coaches and Parents:

Haines Junction Minor Hockey is excited to be hosting the **U13 Yukon Championship** on January 26-28, 2024. **If you are not the contact for U13 in your community, please forward this information to the right person - Thank you!**

TEAMS

It looks like we will have **8 teams** participating in the championships. **If your team can make it to the earlier games on Friday please contact Dana MacKinnon at hjminorhockey@gmail.com.** If you have a limited number of players, we will match you up with more players or another team. **DEADLINE to submit your team roster for the tournament is Friday, January 12, 2024.**

GAME SCHEDULE

We plan to get the final schedule out by **Friday, January 19th, 2024**. Expect the first game to start around 3:00pm Friday and the last game to finish around 4:00pm Sunday. The plan is for all teams to play at least one game on Friday, at least two games on Saturday and at least one game Sunday morning. The playoffs will be scheduled for Sunday, but could start as early as **Saturday night**.

GAMES & RULES

The Playing Rules shall be those of Hockey Yukon (YAHA), as applicable to Minor Hockey and will be distributed by Hockey Yukon.

TIMEKEEPING

HJMH will take care of timekeepers for all games.

REFEREES

Referees must be Hockey Canada certified and will be organized by Hockey Yukon Referee Coordinator.

DRESSING ROOMS

Players must remove their equipment from the dressing rooms when they are not playing.

ROSTERS

Please send us your jersey numbers and players' names in numerical order, as well as your jersey colours and coaches' names by Friday, January 12, 2024. The jersey numbers must be sorted numerically so that we can make up the timekeeping labels in advance. All participants must be registered with their Community Association and BCAHA or their respective provincial, territorial or state Sport Governing Body for insurance reasons.

OVERAGED PLAYERS

If you need over-aged players to make up a team, you are allowed a maximum of four. They can only be one-year over-age and they must play at the U13 level. If they appear to be ringers they could be stopped from playing. This would be decided at the Coaches Meeting Friday night after the last game or at a subsequent meeting.
